

## Recycling News

The city of Columbia now accepts **plastics #1 through #7** for recycling at the drop-off bins around town. We're used to recycling plastic water, soda, or milk bottles (plastic #1 & #2), but this is a big step forward in recycling items such as plastic food containers for yogurt, cottage cheese, fresh fruits and veggies, as well as plastic drinking cups. So be sure to check the little number in the 'recycle triangle' on the bottom of all plastic containers, and as always, rinse out or wash containers as necessary before tossing them in a recycling bag or bin. Did you know that plastic wrap, plastic bags, and aluminum foil or pie tins **cannot** be recycled through the city's recycling program. Columbia hopes to increase their diversion rate--items recycled and not placed in the landfill—from 17 percent to, or above, the national average of 34 percent.



Many of us braved the chilly weather (yes, it was May 31<sup>st</sup>!) to worship outside at the beautiful Baumgartner farm.
