Patricia's Ponderings



Randy, Rev. Patricia, Savannah and Brenda - Clenched hands and hearts can't accept chocolate/forgiveness.

We began the season of Lent with ashes, with dust, with a "smudge." Those of us who attended the Ash Wednesday service were offered this blessing along with the smudge. "Remember that you are beloved, and to love you shall return." This blessing helps ground us in these days of Lent, when we return to the elemental aspects of the soul, and to the meaning of the Christ's message of love.

Artist and poet Jan Richardson reminds us that "we are entering the season that begins with a smudge. That smudge is a testimony to what survives. It is a witness to what abides when everything seems lost. It is a sign that what we know, and love may, for a time, be reduced to dust, but it does not disappear. We belong to the God who well knows what to do with dust, who sees the dust as a place to dream anew, who creates from it again and again."

Our church has recently experienced some great losses, dear ones departing too soon. Our hearts feel that they have been reduced to dust. Lent is a season to reckon honestly with our losses as we journey toward Easter hope with a God who creates again and again from the dust and remains of life's tragedies and griefs. That is how love works.

To be part of this transformation, we need to feel connected, to be part of one another's lives, to share in one another's joys and sufferings. During our Lenten season, I invite you to come earlier than usual, to join us at 9:30 for a brief Lenten devotion followed by coffee and fellowship. I also encourage you to invite your friends. Let's draw the circle wider, include more into the circle of love, community, and caring.

The checking account balance does not include the \$1,221 in offering from Feb 18. The increase in the "special" account is from the Elaine Long memorial and other donations. Once again, currently, our financial situation seems healthy, with enough funds to be somewhat flexible about addressing some infrastructure issues and unanticipated expenses. But please remember: the budget approved by the congregation calls for about \$4,000 per month in regular monthly expenses, and our regular income from pledges and use of the church by the preschool is about \$3,000 per month. That means that we must have about a thousand dollars a month in donations and from fund raisers to fully support our budget. And so, we must remain faithful to those monetary pledges to the church and to our fundraising activities. Thanks!


