Lenten Light

The word "Lent" refers to the "lengthening" light, the return of life and beauty all around us—sunflowers, wheatfields, purple Irises in bloom. What better companion could we ask for during Lent than the artist whose paintings encapsulate the light returning to all these points of beauty: Vincent van Gogh. This year, on four Sundays in Lent (see below*), we will gather before the services at 9:30 in the sanctuary to meditate on the beauty of Lent with images of van Gogh's paintings and Scripture.

The booklet, "Van Gogh and the Beauty of Lent" (The SALT project), which will accompany our viewing, describes the artist this way:


"Vincent van Gogh devoted his life to light. The light of creation, the light of painting, the light of God's grace—and the light in humanity, mind, body, and soul. The son of a Christian pastor, Vincent fervently set out to be a preacher and missionary himself, but his ministry eventually took the form of brush strokes and canvases: in just ten years of his short life, from age 27 to 37, he created more than 2,000 luminous works of art—including nearly 900 paintings—shimmering with vitality and passion, and above all, with light."

During Lent, you will also receive a meditation booklet for every day of the week, with the words of the great theologian Henri Nouwen to accompany you. In other words, we've got you covered for Lent!

May the growing light of Lent find its way into the cracks and crevices of your soul this season. Let us grow in light together as we journey toward Holy Week and the resurrection of our Lord.




April 15th – Good Friday/Tenebrae Services – Service will be by Zoom, and start at 7:00 pm


